Chocolate's family contacted the shelter who scanned his chip and he went home. Later in October we got a call from the family, on a Wednesday, saying they were losing their home, they had to move to a motel and they couldn't keep Chocolate or their other dog. We said we would get him on Friday.

On Thursday night I found out he was at the City Shelter in Casper. Come to find out, Chocolate had yet again gotten out of his yard and this time the family didn't get him, they left him there. We let the Shelter

know his history and luckily we got him into WBHR.

Chocolate went to his first foster home in Sheridan. WY and I think you've maybe been in touch with Janette and Larry, maybe got pictures from them? Anyway, their female heeler picked on "Rocky," so he went to a new foster home in Laramie, WY, with two male Australian Shepherds.

Rocky was adopted in early January, 2011 to a single gal in Rawlins, WY. The day before she picked him up He was found to be called Chocolate from the foster home, she took on a second job and Rocky was kept in a kennel nearly all day, while she worked. That was nearly 7 days a week now, with her taking the second job. Rocky was returned to us on for around one month and he was found by you! Within three to four weeks, his home was with you!
